Reading homework:

Please listen to your child read at least twice a week. This will greatly benefit your child's reading skills and understanding.

Times Tables

The children are taking part in our 'Rainbow Scheme' and will be working through this. Please see the class teacher if you're unsure which times table your child is working on.

In the National Curriculum, all pupils are expected to know all of their times tables, up to 12 x 12, by the end of Year 4. Self-practice of times tables at home has great impact on this. Mathletics

In Year 4, the children will complete Mathletics activities. This is an engaging, interactive tool, which supports learning at school. The teachers are able to track and set appropriate weekly tasks to support your child's learning.

Spellings

Each week your child will receive new spellings. Please support your child in their practice of these spellings.

Topic

Presently, we will not be setting Topic homework for term 1. This will be reviewed again in term 2. This allows the pupils to focus on the other areas for their homework. It is also to prevent many pieces of work and materials being brought into school.
