- ❖ Read Theory will be checked on **MONDAYS**
- ❖ Mathletics will be checked on **WEDNESDAYS**

Reading homework:

We would encourage your child to read every day and ask that you support them at home by listening to them read aloud at least twice a week. This will help them develop fluency and intonation.

Read Theory

Read Theory is an online reading comprehension program that assesses your child's reading ability and improves reading comprehension by providing quizzes for your child to read and answer at an appropriate level.

Your child will complete one Read Theory quiz a week; please note that if your child scores less than 30%, they will be asked to complete another quiz that week, which will automatically be at a more accessible level.

Teachers are able to track and adjust your child's reading level if needed.

Times Tables

The children are taking part in our 'Rainbow Scheme' and will be working through this. Please see the class teacher if you are unsure which times table your child is working on.

Self-practise of times tables at home has great impact on this. For ideas on games and how to practise times tables at home, please see our website (Parent Information - Supporting Learning at Home - Maths).

Mathletics

In Year 5, the children will complete Mathletics activities. This is an engaging, interactive tool, which supports learning at school. The teachers are able to track and set appropriate weekly tasks to support your child's learning.

Spellings

Each week your child will receive new spellings. Please support your child in their practise of these spellings. Your child will also receive an activity to complete that will help your child learn their spellings. This may be a word search or finding out the dictionary definitions of the given spellings.

Topic homework:

Presently, we will not be setting Topic HW for term 1. This will be reviewed again in term 2. This allows the pupils to focus on the other areas for their homework. It is also to prevent many pieces of work and materials being brought into school.
