Mathematics

- Order and compare numbers to at least 1,000,000
- Round numbers up to 1,000,000 to the nearest 10/100/1000/10,000 and 100,000
- Read Roman numerals to 1000 (M) and recognise years written in Roman numerals
- add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits, using formal and mental methods and solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems
- use rounding to check answers
- identify multiples and factors
- use the vocabulary of prime numbers, prime factors and composite (non-prime) numbers
- multiply and divide numbers mentally and recognise and use square numbers and cube numbers
- multiply and divide numbers up to 4 digits using the formal written methods and solve problems
- measure and calculate the perimeter of rectilinear shapes
- calculate and compare the area of rectangles
- compare and order fractions and find equivalent fractions
- recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions
- add and subtract fractions

Learning times tables to 12 x 12 and encouraging the use of Mathematics
