If it ends in ge, you must keep the e: advantage + ous = advantageous If it ends in y, change the y to an i and add ous: vary + ous = various Some words that end in our change to or when you add ous: glamour + ous = glamorous</p> <p>curious adventurous dangerous courageous luxurious mountainous poisonous glamorous hilarious jealous outrageous victorious</p>
<p>SPELLINGS Test: 20.11.23 The Suffix Spelt ‘sion’ with a Buzzing Sound.</p> <p>Rule: If a word ends with a buzzing sound, it is mostly spelt ‘-sion.’</p> <p>vision collision division revision confusion illusion fusion television decision</p>	<p>SPELLINGS Test: 27.11.23 The Suffix Sounding Like /shun/ Spelt -tion</p> <p>Rule: If a word ends with a /shun/ sound, it is mostly spelt –tion.</p> <p>action addition invention location reflection mention emotion audition vibration</p>	<p>SPELLINGS Test: 04.12.23 The Suffix Sounding Like /shun/ Spelt -sion</p> <p>Rule: When the ending follows an -n or -r, it's often spelled -sion, especially if the word is related to one that ends in -d or –se.</p> <p>expansion immersion tension extension occasion suspension convulsion infusion pension</p>
