Personal Social Emotional Development

#### Dreams and Goals & Changing Me

- Discussing personal goals and how they can persevere to tackle challenges
- Identifying and naming parts of the body
- Describing how people grow from babies to adults
- Exploring and expressing feelings about moving to Year 1

## Communication and Language

- Developing their explanations for why things might happen using vocabulary introduced in stories and non-fiction
- Responding to what they hear and see, with relevant comments and questions
- Express their ideas using 'past', 'present' and 'future' vocabulary accurately

## **Physical Development**

- Develop precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball
- Develop and refine a range of ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming.
- Continuing to develop pencil grip and fine motor control through handwriting sessions
- Outdoor activities- balls and scoops, beanbag target practise, throwing and catching with large balls

Regular reading of Little Wandle books and Class Library books. Revising weekly sounds Practising sentence writing; holiday diary All learning is based on the termly topics. This term's topics are: Minibeasts Safari

### Expressive Arts and Design

- Snail collage in the style of Henri Matisse
- Safari animal silhouette painting using graduated colour mixing
